

Instructions for completing Form 1728A Survey of Fraternal Activity

****Please use the following instructions to clarify your logged and reported volunteer hours for 2015:**

Part I: Report all visits to any Sick person whether they are at home, in nursing homes or in the hospital.

Report all visits to those who are bereaved after the loss of a loved one.

Part II: Report number of times you donated blood.

Part III: Report **all volunteer hours** of Community Service

- Any and all hours of Church or Church related activities (this includes hours at Mass or outside of Mass).
- Any and all hours of Community Service (this includes any hours you contribute to your community, its institutions, events or activities).
- Any and all activities contributed to youth and youth activities (****if its connected to kids, log your hours here**)
- All hours contributed to Habitat for Humanity or related activities
- All hours contributed to Culture of Life activities (example: Pro-Life work)
- All hours in support of VAVS (VA and Veterans related activities)
- All hours in support of Food for Families
